Peer reviewed primary qualitative, quantitative and mixed methods research published in English and retrieved from 1/1/2013 to 1/5/2024.	Editorials, theoretical papers, protocols, reviews, and papers published in languages other than English
Research where the primary intervention was community-based suicide prevention or programs to address mental health crises	Research where the primary intervention did not contain a community-based suicide prevention aspect or was not aimed at addressing a mental health crisis.
Studies where the intervention population was identified as Indigenous, farming, youths, or LGBTQIA+	Studies where the intervention population was not clearly identified as Indigenous, or farming, youths, or LGBTQIA+ or where it was not possible to clearly differentiate results for groups of interest.
Studies that were carried out in Australia, New Zealand and/or the Pacific	Studies carried out elsewhere than Australia, New Zealand and/or the Pacific
Studies that reported measurable outcomes on participant knowledge and attitudes to suicide and mental distress, measures of mental health, and suicidality.	Studies that did not report measurable outcomes on participant knowledge and attitudes to suicide and mental distress, measures of mental health, and suicidality or where it was not possible to differentiate the outcomes of interest from other outcomes.
